Children's Mental Health Week

During the week of 3rd February, children across the school explored the theme "Know yourself, grow yourself" for Children's Mental Health Week in partnership with Place 2 Be. The week began with an assembly exploring the unique facets of our personalities and culminated in a range of class-based activities about identifying and managing our emotions. Safer Internet Day

On Tuesday 11th February, the school celebrated 'Safer Internet Day'. The theme for this year was 'Too good to be true'. This theme was focussed around scams online and how to recognise what a scam is. The children explored different ways of identifying a scam and looked at what to do if they think they see a scam whilst online. The children also learnt about not sharing their own personal details online and with others even if they are asked to. During the day the children looked at safe and unsafe passwords and how to make sure that their accounts are safe. The teachers were really impressed with the children's knowledge of online safety and the children enjoyed learning new ways to keep themselves safe online.

On 14th January, a group of our Year 3 & 4 children took part in a local schools Athletics Competition. They performed brilliantly on the day and earned themselves a place in the finals.
