Arbor Parent App

On Tuesday 10th June an email was sent to all parents with the new log in details to set up your Parent Portal and App, please follow these instructions to set up your account. Please ensure you activate your account immediately as school will use this to send in-app messages to parents about all the events we have in school, including parent assemblies, workshops, visits etc.

The Parent Portal works on Google Chrome (computer or laptop) and you can download the Parent App from the App Store or Google Play Store on your phone.

Please note that we will still be using ParentPay for consent to trips and payments of trips/breakfast club/clubs etc.
