Safer Internet Day

On Tuesday 11th February, all the children across the school participated in 'Safer Internet Day'. The children analysed the e-safety acronym 'SMART' and discussed the importance of each letter including never sharing their personal details and always telling an adult if they are unsure about something online or feel uncomfortable. The children then completed lots of exciting activities to embed the e-safety learning including reading e-safety books such as PenguinPig and Goldilocks: A hashtag cautionary tale, acting out scenarios, completing their own posters and taking part in an 'online treasure hunt'. To conclude the afternoon, all the children signed a safer internet agreement to show their understanding and commitment to use the internet safely which they brought home for parents to sign.
