Gas Works

As reported on our last newsletter, Cadent Gas Ltd have started their essential mains gas works and have nearly completed the work on the farm track. During the coming weeks they will be joining up the mains gas on Midfield Road to the mains on Church Lane. This will mean that Cadent will have to excavate a 90m trench along a stretch of Midfield Road heading towards Church Lane. Along Midfield Road Cadent will have to implement a traffic management system to allow the residents to be safe and also allow their personnel to work safely.
