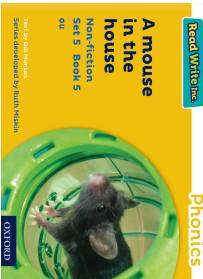

Procedure for Hold a Sentence:

Adult says the sentence and child repeats, have fun saying it in different ways: eg in a high pitched or deep voice, slowly or quickly or even sing it! The aim is for your child to hold the sentence in their head so that they can write it down with as few prompts as possible. Once they have written the sentence they should check that they have used a capital letter, finger spaces between words and a full stop, and that the sentence makes sense.
