Sadly we again need to remind parents about parking around the school entrance at the beginning and end of the day. We are sure that you have heard about the terrible accident which happened on Humberston Avenue at the beginning of the week, where a young girl was hit by a car. The safety of our children is our priority and dangerous parking and vehicle manoeuvring around the school gates puts the safety of your children at great risk. Often when questioned drivers say 'it's only for a few minutes', 'I was just dropping off' – unfortunately it only takes a few minutes for a serious accident to happen. Please do not park or stop outside the school gates, not only does this cause congestion but it also puts your child's life in danger.

Adults/carers wearing masks

In order to keep our school community safe, can we respectfully remind anyone dropping off or collecting children from school, if they are able to, please wear a mask when moving around the school site. Thank you for your consideration.

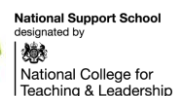
Start and End of the School Day

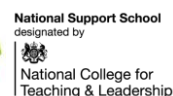
