As you will have seen in the news, following the lifting of many of the Covid restrictions during the summer period, areas of the country have seen an increase in the number of positive cases. Can we please remind parents to remain vigilant and if you or your child show any symptoms please book a PCR test. We would ask that you keep the school informed of any symptoms, tests being taken and results as soon as possible. Currently the guidance we are following states that if your child has symptoms and has booked a test/are awaiting results they cannot be in school, however siblings, providing they do not have symptoms can attend school.
