Mini First Aid Course

Last week we were lucky enough to invite a trainer from Mini First Aid Lincolnshire in to school to teach first aid to every year group. Each session was targeted with age appropriate activities, our FS/KS1 children could be seen applying plasters, making 999 calls to a pretend operator and putting each other in the recovery position whilst the KS2 children covered these in addition to basic CPR, cuts and bruises and choking. This was a practical, hands on experience for all of the children and one which has enabled them to gain valuable life skills. The trainer was very complimentary about all of the children's behaviour and their eagerness to respond to a range of questions. Well done children!

Football Report

Following the success of the girls' football team, our Yr 5/6 boys and Yr 4/5 boys' teams have taken part in some brilliant games over the past few weeks. W/c 4th October, the Yr 5/6 boys team put in a solid performance against 9 different teams during their games and worked really well as a team throughout. It has been an incredible month with the children returning to representing the school in competitions. We are increasingly concerned by the number of children in schools across the country who have been talking about and re-enacting the games from Squid Games, a Netflix show that is highly inappropriate for young children due to the high levels of violence and other disturbing adult themes.

Please be aware that children are able to access scenes from Squid Games via places such as TikTok as it can pop up on their 'For You' page and therefore even if they are not searching for it, they can come across scenes, which are disturbing. If your child has access to TikTok, Discord, Roblox, YouTube or Netflix, or have friends or relatives who have, they may well have come across it and we would like to raise awareness of this in order to safeguard our pupils.
